

Overhead video (also known as drop screens) are trendy and useful as the backseat babysitter. Most useful are the ones with a built in DVD player. Avoid swivel type screen units-they break easily-stick to solid full width hinged units. Hinges that seem a little to tight in the beginning will stay tight for years and not get sloppy. The 10" size screen is very popular and looks great in most larger SUVs. Make sure the installer mounts the unit so the screen is directly between the two front headrests when fully "dropped". When the driver turns their head to look behind them you won't hit your head on the screen, and it hurts! Also in most states it is illegal for the screen to be visible to the driver at any time. Your kids will thank you.....really!
